

RECORD NOTE OF DISCUSSIONS OF THE ONLINE PRE-BID MEETING HELD AT 15.00 HOURS ON 16-07-2021 IN CONNECTION WITH TENDER FOR THE WORK OF "CONSTRUCTION OF INTERNATIONAL AND DOMESTIC CRUISE TERMINAL AND OTHER ALLIED FACILITIES AT MORMUGAO PORT TRUST, GOA, THROUGH ENGINEERING, PROCUREMENT AND CONSTRUCTION (EPC) CONTRACT" (TENDER NO. T15/T-1946/2021-C)

The meeting commenced at 15.00 hrs.

At the outset, Chief Engineer, CoPT, welcomed all the participants and then gave a brief description of the work under this tender. Chief Engineer informed that this work is taken up by Cochin Port on behalf of Mormugao Port Trust (MoPT) as Project Management Consultant and M/s. Team One India Ltd. is the Architectural Engineering & Design Consultant for the project, engaged by MoPT. The Chief Engineer further informed that certain written queries were received from some prospective bidders and replies to the written queries shall be uploaded and any queries which need specific clarifications shall be dealt now.

Regarding extension of due date of submission of the bid, Chief Engineer informed that period of about 14 days after uploading the Replies to Pre-bid queries shall be given for submission of the bid.

The Chief Engineer also suggested that all bidders shall inspect the project site at Mormugao Port within 23/07/2021 and shall submit further queries if any by 25/07/2021. The bidders who wish to visit the project site shall make a written request and CoPT shall arrange with MoPT officials to provide necessary assistance during the site inspection. The bidders who have not yet submitted the queries in writing are also requested to submit their queries in writing.

It is also informed that the queries of the bidders and the responses of CoPT thereto will be uploaded in the e tender portal, CoPT's web site and Govt. tender web site as Addendum / Corrigendum, which shall be part of the Bid document and shall be duly signed and submitted along with the Bid.

The Chief Engineer concluded the meeting at 16.30hrs, thanking all present.
